Answer the following questions AS your character:

1. What is your opinion of Boingo about half way through the movie?
2. Were you surprised that he was the Goodie Bandit? Why or why not?
3. Looking back, now knowing what you know, are there any clues in Boingo's behavior that told you he was an evil genius?
4. Because you were looking at the story from your perspective, give three examples where you may have judged someone incorrectly. Explain your examples. (Be sure to consider your character traits when you answer this.)

Write a paragraph(s) describing how personal perspective can affect how an individual views a situation. Use specific examples from the movie Hoodwinked.

Have a topic sentence with at least six supporting sentences. Have a wrap up sentence.

Topic sentence: Very specifically state your main idea;

Examples:

Perspective can greatly affect how a person views a situation.

Not knowing all the facts, can alter a person's view on reality.

A person's point of view can vary greatly from another's, which in turn can affect how each person views the situation.

Support: Use at least six sentences to support your topic sentence. Be sure to use examples from character's different perspectives in the movie.

Wrap up: Make sure to have one or two sentences to wrap up your paragraph. Often times referring back to your lead makes a nice satisfying wrap up.

Examples:

If you start with a quote, refer back to it (state it in another way perhaps.)

If you create a situation, go back to that situation.

If you asked questions, perhaps answer them.
